SGM Erskine served as a US Army Recruiter in Champaign, Illinois from 2000-2003.

From 1997-2000, he served in NATO, as a Technical Control NCO in Brunssum, Netherlands.

SGM Erskine was stationed at Fort Huachuca, Arizona working as a tactical satellite operator for the 298th Signal Company, 86th Signal Battalion from 1995 to 1997.

From 1993-1994, he was an Electronic Maintenance NCO with Bravo Company, 304th Signal Battalion in Camp Long, South Korea.

He entered the US Army in 1992 and completed Basic Combat Training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina, followed by Advanced Individual Training at Fort Gordon, Georgia for MOS 31P, Microwave Systems Operator/Maintainer.

SGM Erskine's military and civilian education includes all levels the NCO Professional Development System, the Commander's Safety Course, Equal Opportunity Leader Course, Recruiter Course, Master Resiliency Training Course, First Sergeant Course, and the Army Basic Space Cadre Course.
