



Mr Peter Scaruppe

Director Acquisition

Mr Peter Scaruppe took up the post of Director Acquisition for the NATO Communications and Information (NCI) Agency on 1 October 2013.

Previously, from May 2011 to September 2013 Mr Scaruppe was Industry and Market Director at the European Defence Agency (EDA). There he was in charge of EDA's work to develop a globally competitive European Defence Equipment Market and a capability driven European Defence Technological and Industrial Base.

Before assuming this position, he was Assistant Director for Defence Market at the EDA Industry and Market Directorate from 2009. His responsibilities encompassed the coordination of the Agency's initiatives to increase transparency, competition and fair opportunities in the European Defence Equipment Market, develop Security of Supply arrangements and address the specificities of the defence market.

Prior to that, he served as Head of Division, Analyses and Armaments Economics in the Directorate General of Armaments of the German Federal Ministry of Defence, Bonn. There, among other duties, he was in charge of defence industrial affairs and he represented Germany in the Letter of Intent (LoI) Executive Committee, which he chaired in 2004.

From 1999 to 2004 he served as Counselor for Defense Cooperation and Economics at the German Embassy in Washington, D.C.

From 1995 to 1999, he worked in various capacities in the Directorate General of Armaments of the German FMoD. During that time he was on the team representing Germany in Panel III (Procedures and Legal Affairs) of the Western European Armaments Group (WEAG).

From 1985 to 1995, Mr Scaruppe worked for the Federal Office for Military Technology and Procurement in Koblenz, Germany. Within that period, he participated in the Scientists and Engineers Exchange Program between the German Federal Ministry of Defence and the US Department of Defense and was assigned as a Cost and Price Analyst to the US Air Force at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida, USA.

He graduated Diplom-Kaufmann (equivalent of a Master's Degree in Business) from the University of the German Armed Forces, Hamburg.

Mr Scaruppe is a member of the European Peace and Security Studies Academic Advisory Council at Vesalius College, Brussels, and a member of the Presidency Committee of the German Association for Defence Technology.
