2022 with an anticipated Contract Award by Q1 2023.

1. In accordance with References A-C, notice is given of the intent of the NATO Communications and Information Agency (NCI Agency) to issue a Request for Quote (RFQ) to establish a Firm Fixed Price (FFP) Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) framework using multiple funding sources at the NATO Enterprise level;
2. A summary of the requirements of the RFQ are set forth in Annex A attached to this letter. These requirements are currently being refined as part of the preparation of the proposed RFQ;
3. The reference for this RFQ is RFQ-CO-115665-LSF and all correspondence concerning this RFQ should reference this number;
4. The envisaged procurement procedure for this RFQ is Basic Ordering Agreement (BOA) Plus (BOA+). The successful bidder, pursuant to the RFQ following this NOI, will be the bid that offers the lowest price and are technically compliant in accordance with the evaluation criteria prescribed in the RFQ. The Agency seeks to award one contract;
5. The formal RFQ is planned to be issued September 2022, and Contract Award is planned for no later than March 2023;
6. Attached to this letter at Annex B is a list of potential bidders that may be able to provide the services and equipment required for this project. This list was compiled from the companies that have an active BOA with the Agency;
7. The BOA+ procedures allow National Responsible Authorities to nominate eligible bidders in addition to the companies identified at Annex B. Any such nominations for companies that do not have an active BOA should come from the National Authorities via their Delegation/Mission to NATO, who will provide the requisite Declaration of Eligibility (DoE). Upon receipt of the DoE, the NCI Agency Contracting Officer will add the company to the Bidders List;



8. National Responsible Authorities are kindly requested to provide a list to the NCI Agency with Declarations of Eligibility, **not later than 19 August 2022**, of qualified and certified companies which may be interested in receiving a Request for Quote for this project.

In addition to the firms certification of security clearance required:

10. National authorities are advised the RFQ package is anticipated to be NATO UNCLASSIFIED; however, the RFQ and the contractual documents could contain references to other NATO documents classified as NATO RESTRICTED
11. The successful bidder(s) may be required to handle and store classified information up to the level of NATO SECRET. In addition, Contractor personnel may be required to work unescorted in Class II Security areas and therefore, access can only be permitted to cleared individuals. Only companies maintaining such cleared facilities and the appropriate personnel clearances will be able to perform the resulting contract

**Summary of the Requirements**  
**RFQ-CO-115665-LSF**

**1. Introduction**

- a. The NCIA Logistics team mission is to provide optimum logistics services across the Agency and wider NATO sites, and to continually improve the ease of movement of business related assets across various NATO sites.
- b. Over the past 24 months, the NCIA Logistics team has been requested to provide services to support various projects across different NCI Agency business areas. In doing so, the team has utilised a mix of both in-house and external resources to support these projects. Following the increase in requirements, the team is seeking to establish a framework agreement for logistics services known as the Logistics Services Framework (LSF).

**2. Project Scope**

- a. NCIA aims to establish an IDIQ framework with one supplier as the vehicle for the provision of Industry logistics services.
- b. The aim of the IDIQ framework is to ensure a broad scope; however, for indicative purposes a non-exhaustive list of potential core services could include any combination of the following:
  1. Traditional logistics services covering packaging, handling, storage, and transportation, including the provision of labour, materials and support equipment in support of those logistics services.
  2. Rental of storage and staging facilities, such as local warehouses near NATO locations, ISO-containers for temporary storage, and porta-cabins for temporary staging activities, including placement and collection of temporary structures, as well as the provision of labour, materials, and support equipment typically required for storage and staging activities.
  3. Rental of vehicles, materials and support equipment, in support of logistics activities, such as rental of small trucks and forklifts, including drivers, rental of pallet jacks, moveable carts, and stair climbers, as well as rental of crates, boxes, and provision of packaging and sealing materials, et cetera.
  4. Reverse logistics services covering packaging handling, storage, and transportation of legacy equipment and typical packaging waste, including placement and collection of waste skips, and including recycling and disposal activities, as well as the provision of labour, materials and support equipment in support of reverse logistics.



5. Hiring of personnel to support general logistics activities, ranging from hands-on labour to administration, planning, and management of logistics activities.

c. Subsequent Task Orders will define the full scope, although it is envisaged that all services and associated goods and services procured under this IDIQ shall include delivery to NATO sites.

### **3. Geographical Information**

The Contractor shall supply equipment and services to all authorized NATO Command Locations in Europe and North America including any of NATO 's Affiliates, upon issuance of Task Orders in accordance with the terms of the Contract. The list of existing affiliates is available at:
