Annex A – Summary of Requirements

Project No. [2022/0CM03045-0/9] / [2022/1CM03055-0/9]

1. Project Objective

The project scope is to establish a contract for the provision of two (2) OSG kits, five (5) SNF Kits, and MAF infrastructure & services, and to prove that the specific technical services can operate over this infrastructure. In addition, the Project will prove that Purchaser Furnished Equipment (PFE) are integrated to the Flagship CIS Kits.

2. Scope of Work

The Contractor will have to execute a series of tasks in order to meet NATO's requirement to deliver an effective and efficient Command and Control (C2) system. A new, permanent, fully accredited, reliable and scalable Network is required in support of the purpose above.

The systems to be delivered, hereafter referred to as the FLAGSHIP CIS KITS, will give NATO MARCOM and NATO Nation deployed forces access to NATO's strategic communication infrastructure and provide secure and non-secure voice, video and data services.

3. Period of Performance

The Period of Performance is anticipated to start in Q1 2024 and end in Q1 2025. It is important to note that this timeline represents the anticipated duration of the Project, and adjustments may be made as per the requirements of the solicitation process and subsequent contractual agreement.
