### Sergeant Major Timothy Erskine

#### Senior Enlisted Advisor

SGM Erskine is currently assigned as the Senior Enlisted Advisor to the General Manager (GM) and Chief of Staff (COS) for the NATO Communications and Information Agency (NCIA), Brussels, Belgium. He advises the GM, COS and staff on matters pertaining to troop welfare and morale in terms of assignment, reassignment, utilization, promotion, privileges, and discipline for all enlisted ranks within the NCI Agency.

He entered the U. S. Army in 1992 and completed Basic Combat Training followed by Advanced Individual Training for Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) 31P, Microwave Systems Operator/Maintainer.

His first duty assignment was as an Electronic Maintenance NCO with Bravo Company, 304th Signal Battalion at Camp Long, South Korea from 1993 to 1994 providing long haul communications support to the Third Republic of Korea Army (TROKA) during exercises conducting throughout the South Korean peninsula. He has served in various assignments working in the Satellite Communications (SATCOM) field starting with the 298th Signal Company, 86th Signal Battalion, Ft. Huachuca, Arizona working as a tactical satellite operator from 1995 to 1997. His first assignment in NATO was with Allied Forces Central Europe HQs from 1997-2000, as a Technical Control NCO and IVSN Switch Operator in Brunssum, Netherlands maintaining vital communications links throughout Europe and North America.

SGM Erskine served as a US Army Recruiter in Champaign, Illinois with the Peoria Recruiting Company, Saint Louis Recruiting Battalion from 2000-2003.

He served in the S3 Operations section of the 32nd Signal Battalion, Darmstadt, Germany from 2003 to 2007 to include a deployment to Iraq in 2005 where he worked with Balad Airbase planners on base infrastructure projects and later led a fiber installation team on FOB Warhorse. From 2008 to 2009, he served in the 5th Signal Command G3 section in Mannheim, Germany, responsible for education and training needs within the command.

From 2009 to 2012, he was the First Sergeant for Alpha Company and 298th Signal Company, 302nd Signal Battalion, Ft. Detrick, Maryland providing SATCOM support to the Eastern US and Atlantic region from the unit's Strategic Tactical Entry Point site. His fifth overseas assignment was with the Korea Theater Network Operations and Security Center (K-TNOSC) from 2012 to 2013 serving as the Action Request Center NCOIC and K-TNOSC Sergeant Major at Camp Walker, South Korea, supporting theater signal network operations for the warfighter on the peninsula.

From 2013 to 2015, he served as the Battalion S3 Operations Non-commissioned Officer in Charge for the 52nd Signal Battalion, Stuttgart, Germany supporting the USEUCOM and USAFRICOM HQs. His last assignment in the SATCOM community was as the First Sergeant of Delta Company, Wideband SATCON Operations Center (WSOC), 53rd Signal Battalion at Wahiawa, Hawaii from 2015 to 2017 providing SATCOM support to USPACOM, 21st Infantry Division, and allied partners in the Pacific Region.

SGM Erskine's military and civilian education includes all levels of the Non-commissioned Officer Professional Development System, the Commander's Safety Course, Equal Opportunity Leader Course, Recruiter Course, Master Resiliency Training Course, First Sergeant Course, the Army Basic Space Cadre Course and he is a graduate of the United States Army Sergeant Major Academy Ft. Bliss, Texas (Class 68). He has a Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Tennessee.
