## Annex A – Summary of Requirements

Project No. 2022/OIS03005, CP9A3201

### 1. Project Objective

The project aims to enhance the existing on-premises CTI capability; and to provide centralized threat intelligence ingestion, management, analysis, sharing, visualization, automation, and integration functions, leading to effective categorization, augmentation and correlation of data. The Contractor shall build, update and create an effective solution to receive existing commercial and specific internal feeds, perform the analysis and processing, and integrate to other existing cyber security systems to allow timely, accurate and effective use of the intelligence.

### 2. Scope of Work

This project shall: enhance the existing MISP (Malware Information Sharing Platform) environment in NCIA; integrate other commercially off-the-shelf ('COTS') components; provide complementary functionality; ensure effective use of existing data sources with possible automation/ intelligence; and, if necessary, replace existing components (except MISP) or add new one.

The work includes:

1. Refinement of Solution Requirements and design;
2. Any implementation activity (installation, configuration, ...) on required network segments with different classifications including NATO UNCLASSIFIED, NATO RESTRICTED and NATO SECRET;
3. Integration to existing systems for input / output flows and hosting infrastructure;
4. Documentation of the implemented solution (e.g. system manuals, administration manuals, user manuals, CIS descriptions, Service Level Agreements, etc.);
5. Support to testing and validation of the solution (i.e. FAT, SAT, and UAT) prior to final deployment;
6. Support to transitioning the implementation from the contractor to operations; and
7. Training on the new CTI capabilities, their operation and usage, and enhancements that these may bring in terms of doctrine (i.e. processes) and interoperability (i.e. ingestion/consumption of CTI data from other sources).

The expected outcome of this project is to have improved CTI handling and sharing capability by introducing automation, improved control and better visibility.

This capability will be procured with BOA+ on a Firm Fixed Price Basis to the Lowest Priced

Technically Compliant Bidder.

### **3. Period of Performance**

The period of performance is expected to start in Q1 2027 and end in Q3 2029. It is important to note that this timeline represents the anticipated duration of the project and adjustments may be made as per the requirements of the solicitation process and the subsequent contractual arrangements.

### **4. Warranty and O&M Support**

- a. Following acceptance of the final operational delivery, the contract will require warranty for any software delivered.
- b. The contract is expected to include O&M support following acceptance of the final operational delivery.
